## **2. Sports News – All – Information**

### **Y3/4 Gifted and Talented Individual Indoor Athletics Pentathlon:**

Each athlete had to compete in 5 events (vertical jump, long jump, speed bounce, chest push and sprinting) and were awarded points for each event. In the Boys event Charlie P finished 10<sup>th</sup>, Elliot joint 8<sup>th</sup> and Theo 6<sup>th</sup> out of the 14 competitors. The Girls – Sophie finished 15<sup>th</sup>, Eva-Betsy 6<sup>th</sup> and Matilida was runner-up, she also won the long jump event with a jump of 1m70.
