On a wet afternoon 3 teams (24 pupils) went to the leisure centre to take part in the WSSA Quadkids Athletics tournament. In the event each athlete has to complete a 75m sprint, 600m run, a standing long jump as well as throwing a howler as far as the can. It was a high level of competition with 10 teams competing in total.
