

# Planning an Imaginary Setting Description

It's time to start planning your own setting description.

First, make notes on these details of your setting. What are you describing?

Size (e.g. a town; a room):		How much space do you need to describe?
Location (e.g. the kingdom of <u>Deryuss</u> ):		Create a fantasy place to make your setting feel like it is part of a larger world.
Inhabitants (What creatures and people are here?):		Think about whether your main character will see things living here or just clues showing that creatures are nearby.
Focus (What draws your eye in this place?)		This feature will take up the biggest section of your description.
