





Hindus recognise one supreme God, **Brahman**. Brahman is present everywhere. The gods and goddesses of Hinduism are different aspects of Brahman.

The main three aspects (Trimurti) are:

#### Vishnu, Brahma and Shiva



Brahman is in you and me.








