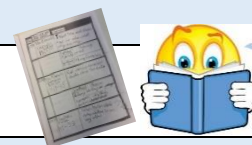

Spellings are learnt fortnightly across 2 weeks running from Wednesday to Tuesday.
We are currently in Week 2.

Spelling Week 2 commences Wednesday 20/01/21 and concludes Tuesday 26/01/21. Week 2 includes a mid-point assessment at the start of the week to identify which spellings the children have learnt during week 1 and a further spelling test at the end of the week to identify which spellings they learnt during the 2 weeks

Spelling Week 1 commences on Wednesday 27/01/21 and concludes Tuesday 02/02/21. Week 1 includes an initial test at the start of the week to identify which words the children already know.
