### Executive Summary

#### 1.1. Introduction

This report details the outcomes from the latest pupil wellbeing questionnaire. The questionnaire uses questions in line with Ofsted Parent View: <https://parentview.ofsted.gov.uk/parent-view-results> for us to compare parent and pupil views in the school on the same issues. There are a few additional questions to the Parent View ones that seek pupils' views on the school and their wellbeing. The final two questions allow for pupils to express their opinions on improvements the school can make and the best things Chesswood offers. Due to the language used in some questions, teachers explained the question before pupils completed the questionnaire on iPads in class.

The survey was completed by 580 pupils (out of 620) in all classes during the week of 14-18 December 2020.

Pupil comments regarding improvements were followed up in incidents where it was deemed teachers needed to be aware of the issues raised. The school council and school governors will be provided with the information in this report to consider whether they can take any ideas for improvements into future action.

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### 1.3. Grade Guides

Outstanding – exceptionally positive pupil feedback - 90% Agree and =>40% Strongly Agree
Good – positive pupil feedback <=80 Agree and =>30% Strongly Agree
Attention Required – satisfactory pupil feedback <=70 Agree and => 20% Strongly Agree
Immediate Attention Required – inadequate pupil feedback <70 Agree and <20% Strongly Agree

The threshold numbers above **guide a professional judgment** on the feedback from pupils.

### 1.4. Key Outcomes

The majority of responses to questions are good and outstanding, with the only exceptions linked to the lack of clubs, activities and trips that are not possible due to COVID-19 restrictions.

- 89% (38%) of pupils are happy at Chesswood.
- 91% (42%) of pupils feel safe at school.
- 87% (35%) of pupils agree that adults in school make sure children are well behaved.
- 92% (69%) of pupils agree that discriminatory comments and actions are not tolerated at Chesswood.
- 87% (58%) of pupils agree that bullies and bullying are not tolerated at Chesswood.
- 91% (52%) pupils agree they know somebody will help them if they are worried or upset at school.
- 94% (60%) of pupils agree that the teachers and teaching assistants have high expectations for them.
- 85% (40%) of pupils agree that they are doing well at Chesswood.
- 87% (39%) of pupils know how they are doing in lessons and what to do next to improve.
- 83% (47%) of pupils agree that there is a good range of subjects they can learn at Chesswood.
- 82% (41%) of pupils agree that they can take part in clubs and activities at Chesswood.
- 90% (53%) of pupils would tell other children to come to Chesswood.
- 89% (57%) of pupils agree Chesswood Junior School is a great school.



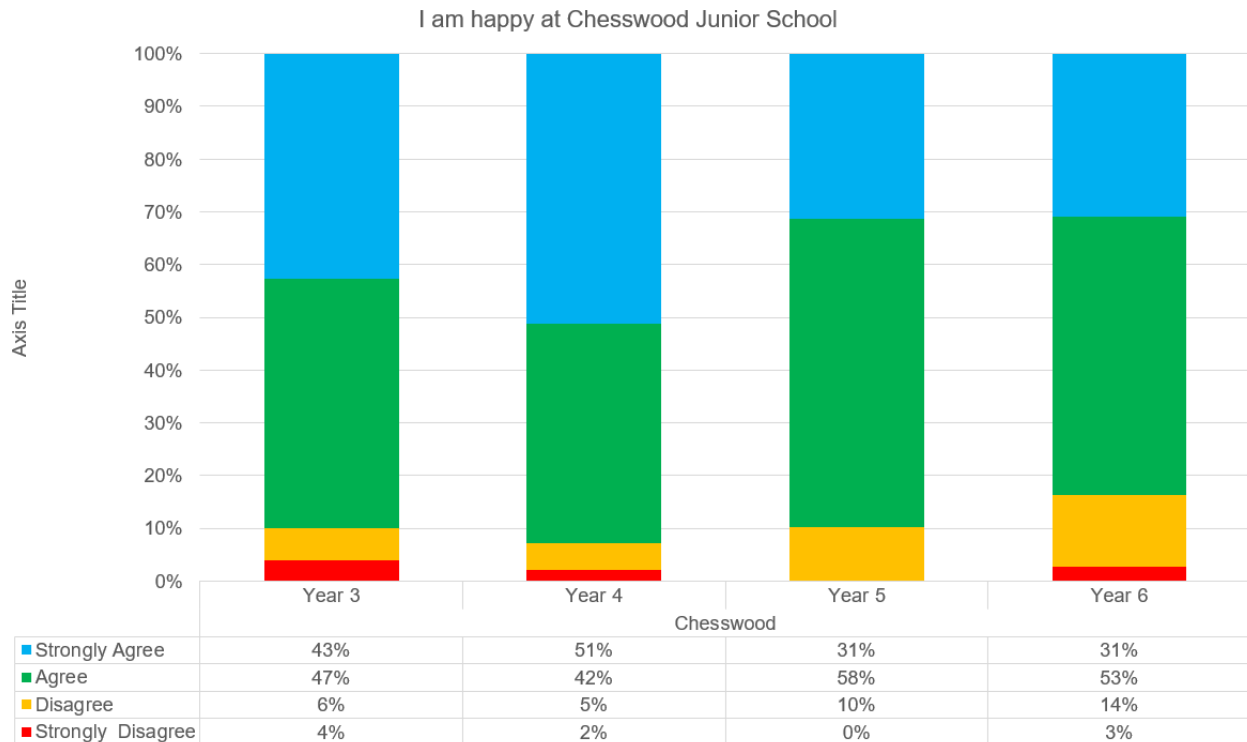

- The school could improve by with racism and sexism and homophobia they don't deal with it properly and if I'm worried or upset they only say if I'm ok and what's wrong it doesn't help and with bullying, they only have to apologise and a tiny bit of a punishment and they take a day or two to sort it out and I'm not happy at school because I just don't feel well fitted in
- We can learn more about behaviour and physical actions maybe?
- I think the school is sexist as boys are always telling me what I can and can't do for example football they are rude to me because they think girls should just be in the kitchen. But it's not only the children it's also clubs such as girls' football and boys' choir the clubs are very limited. I usually join the mixed football club because the children there are more experienced then the girls' football but when I join, they make me feel unwelcome like I don't belong there. And even boys are limited because once a boy joined crochet and was teased from being gay this is not good.
- Chesswood could do something that shows us what adult life is like and what the workplace is like
- At the end of the month a questionnaire on reflection , mental health and feelings for example things that have happened in that month at school or at home or things that they have struggled with in lessons so the teachers can be more aware as some people do not like sharing in front of the class in PSHE.
- More chances for pupils to help the school and recommend ideas
- Irritating COVID-19 rules: no football and sanitiser every time we leave the classroom
- Nothing / Nothing could because I think it is a good school
- Shut it down!
