Synonyms - different words which have the same meaning.

Conjunctions - used to link ideas within a sentence.

Pronouns - used to show that the writer is referring back to a person or object they've already named.

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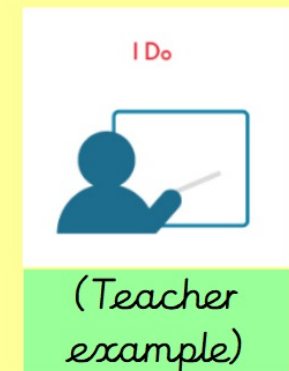

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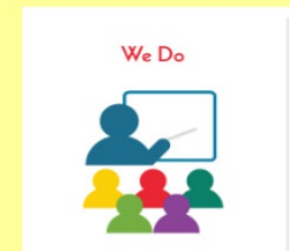
