We can use adverbs to modify our sentence to show the possibility of something happening. For example; surely, definitely, possibly, perhaps

He woke with a start and sat up. Outside it was light. it was late morning perhaps, or early afternoon.

We can also use a modal verb to modify our sentence to show the possibility of something happening. For example; might, can, shall, may, must

What was in the drawer included things that might be mended one day.
