Definitions

Miracle

An event that cannot be explained by natural or scientific laws, it happens outside the usual rules of nature / expectation. However, Christians believe that Jesus performed many miracles, including healing, during his lifetime.

Healing

the process of making or becoming sound or healthy again.

Disciples


Jesus chose 12 of his closest friends to help him to share the teachings of God as they travelled together.

The son of God. There is historic proof that Jesus was a man who existed on the Earth however Christians believe that he was the son of God and able to heal people to open their eyes to the existence of God. Christians believe that Jesus is God in human form.

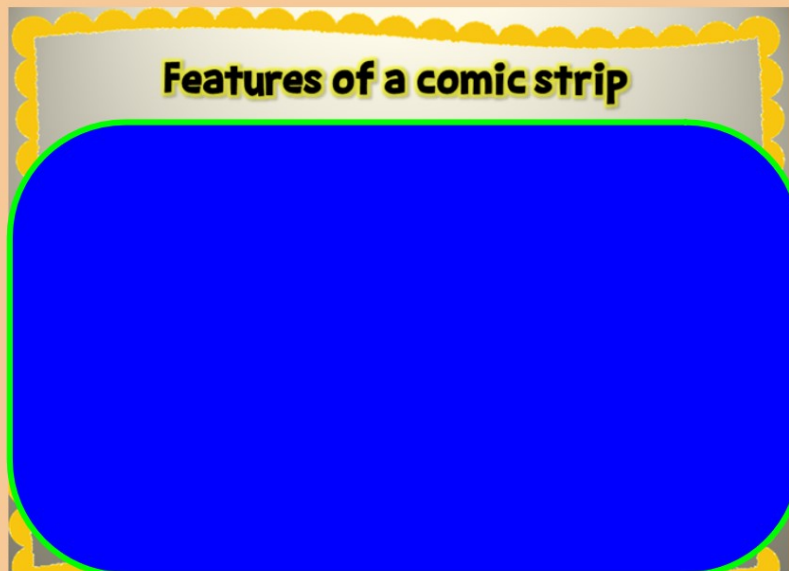


What is a comic storyboard?

What are the features of a Comic Strip?

Features of a comic strip

Speech bubbles are usually round or square shapes with a tail pointing to the character's mouth, indicating that the character is speaking out loud.



Features of a comic strip

A scream bubble indicates a character is screaming or shouting and has a jagged outline or a thicker line. The letters are usually larger or bolder than normal.



Features of a comic strip

Thought bubbles are cloud-shaped word bubbles that indicate that a character is thinking, not talking out loud.



Features of a comic strip



Action words indicate the sounds that can be heard in a comic strip. They are usually in coloured jagged splats, and the letters are all in capitals.

Quite often, exclamation marks are used!

☐ Jesus attends a wedding in Cana, Galilee.



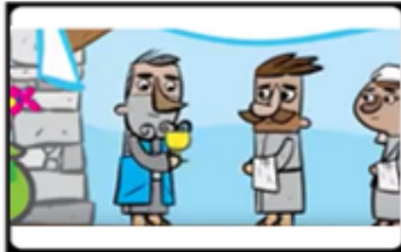
☐ In the middle of the party the wine ran out.



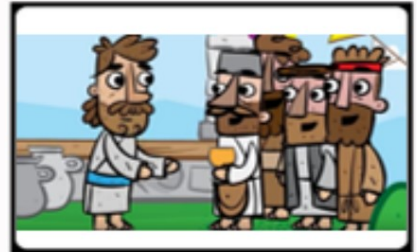
☐ Mary tells the servant "do whatever he tells you".
