	CREATE ATMOSPHERE: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sense descriptions <i>see, hear, smell, feel, taste</i> • Powerful, descriptive adjectives (<i>describing nouns</i>) and adverbs (<i>describing verbs/actions</i>) • Fronted adverbials (try 2!) <i>Suddenly, out of nowhere,...</i> 	
	Extra information/detail using subordinate clauses <i>ISAWAWABUB</i> and relative clauses <i>who, which...</i>	
	Modal verbs (<i>what might have, could have happened.....</i>)	
	Use semi-colons/colons to separate independent clauses	
	Range of different types of clause structure (subordinate, relative) in different positions
