Structure		<b>Introduction</b> - introduce Zephyr, any other characters and the setting.	
		<b>Build up</b> - what is Zephyr doing at the beginning of the story?	
		<b>Problem</b> - Is your story about climate change, wind power, electricity or windy weather? Your problem will be linked to this.	
		<b>Fix problem</b> - will Zephyr come to the rescue with their inventions?	
		<b>Ending</b> - the problem has been fixed. Has anything changed? Has anyone learnt anything?	
Language		<b>Expanded noun phrases</b>	
		<b>Conjunctions</b>	
		<b>Fronted adverbials</b>	
		<b>Relative clauses</b>	
		<b>Parenthesis</b>	
		<b>Speech punctuation</b>	
		<b>Show not tell</b>	



WALT: proofread and edit our story

You now need to proofread your work.

You need to check the following:

- capital letters **Aa**
- commas for lists, fronted adverbials and relative clauses ,
- full stops .
- correct and consistent tense (**past**)
- correct person - **3rd person**
- apostrophes for contractions and possession'
- question marks/exclamation marks **?!**
- inverted commas " "
- **SPELLING!**
