Music	Activity 3 – writing notes on the stave Using the Knowledge Organiser revise the names of the notes in the treble clef. Remember, when you draw the black music dot onto the ladder (the stave), the dot must either be squished between in the lines (in a space) or it must have a line running through it (on a line), a dot cannot be in a space and have a line running through it. Using the Music Manuscript paper provided, practise drawing the dots on the music ladder. Draw them on the lines (EGBDF) or in a space (FACE) Practise drawing a treble clef. Have a go at spelling words like DAD, CAB, BED, ACE, EGG, BADGE and GAG using dots. For example, write DAD by drawing a dot on the D line and a dot in the A space.
