

Spellings are learnt fortnightly across 2 weeks running from Wednesday to Tuesday.

Spelling Week I commences on Wednesday 10/02/21 and concludes Tuesday 23/02/21. Week I includes an initial test at the start of the week to identify which words the children already know.

Spelling Week 2 commences Wednesday 24/02/21 and concludes Tuesday 02/03/21. Week 2 includes a mid-point assessment at the start of the week to identify which spellings the children have learnt during week I and a further spelling test at the end of the week to identify which spellings they learnt during the 2 weeks.


