Metaphors compare different things.

They suggest that two things are the same.

Here are some examples:

I have the heart of a lion!

You are the apple of my eye.

The children in my class are a dream!

It's raining cats and dogs.

I'm standing at the foot of the mountain.

All the world's a stage, And all the men and women merely players; They have their exits and their entrances;

The difference between a simile and a metaphor is that a simile says someting is *like* something else, but a metaphor says that something *is* something else.

Simile

The girl was <u>as</u> beautiful <u>as</u> a rose.

Is LIKE a rose

Metaphor

The girl <u>was a</u> beautiful rose.

IS a rose
