




Settlements can be ranked according to their population size and the level of services available.

Geographers look for patterns.

The bigger the settlement, the more services it has.







- isolated dwelling often in rural areas few buildings
- hamlet tiny collection of houses, sometimes around farms with no shops <100
- village small with few shops, place of worship and maybe school
 100-1,000
- town medium-sized with shopping centres and factories
 1,000-100,000
- city (-ies) large with lots of services and sometimes a cathedral
 100,000-Imillion
- metropolis city and surrounding towns that have started to merge I-3million
- conurbation group of large cities and suburbs with strong links
 3-10 million
- megalopolis conurbations join to become one large urban area
 10million+



a hierarchy: a system in which people or things are organised into different levels of importance from highest to lowest.

This pyramid shows settlement hierarchy.



Another pattern about settlements: as they become bigger and more important, they are fewer and further between!

Position in a settlement hierarchy can also depend on how far people will travel to use the services in the settlement. If people travel further, the place becomes more important and ranks higher in settlement hierarchy.

Different settlements have different levels of infrastructure.


