What is a fronted adverbial?



A fronted adverbial is when an adverbial verb or phrase is moved to the front of the sentence, before the verb. It adds extra information to the sentence.

Mum allows us to choose a sweet from the shop occasionally.

Make sure you put a comma after the fronted adverbial.

Occasionally, Mum allows us to choose a sweet from the shop. fronted adverbial


