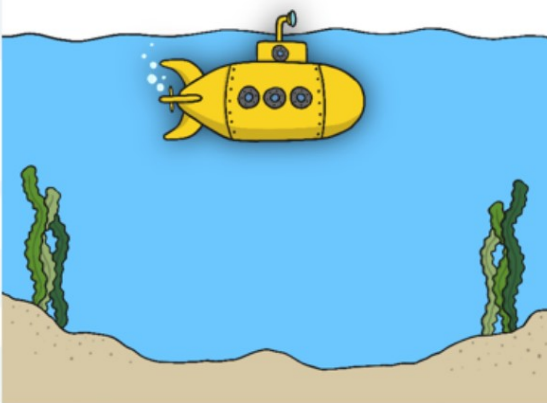

A **prefix** is added to the **beginning** of a word to make a new word.

Most prefixes are added to the beginning of **root words** without any changes in spelling.

The root word **marine** could have the prefix **sub-** added to it to make a new word **submarine**

It is important to understand the definitions of prefixes because they help us to figure out the meanings of any new words that we learn.

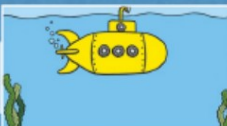

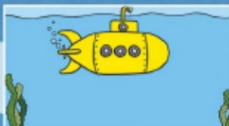

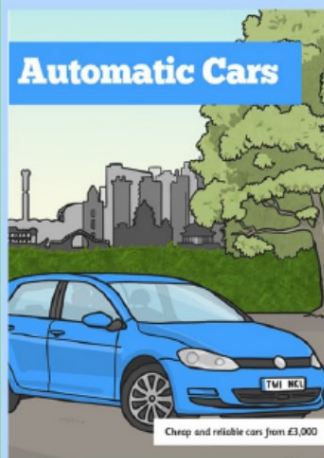
