- spellings (especially homophones eg to, too, two)
- punctuation (capital letters, apostrophes, commas)
- have you missed out any words?
- · have you repeated any words?
- · have you missed an 's' or 'ed' at the end of a word?
- · do your sentences all make sense?
- · have you underlined headings and used capital letters?!

Editing: REREAD AGAIN!

- have you got lots of simple, short sentences?
 Relative /subordinate clauses and parenthesis to make sentences longer
- do your sentences start the same way?
 Fronted adverbials/start with a subordinating clause, noun phrase or imperative try changing the word order around!
- have you repeated any words several times?
 Synonyms, pronouns to avoid repetition
 - have you used emotive language to make the reader feel and understand what you're writing about?
