

Draw a line to connect each pair of boxes

Step 6

The flower's bright petals and sweet smell attract the bees and insects.



Step 1

The insect arrives on the flower to collect nectar.



Step 4

As the insect is gathering nectar, pollen rubs onto the bee.



Step 3

After the insect has finished feeding, it gets attracted by another flower



Step 2

The pollen stuck to the bee rubs off onto the female parts of the second flower (the stigma)



Step 5

Part of the pollen travels down the style and into the ovary.
