


# NASTY WRITING!

## Semi-colons

Semi-colons can be used to connect two sentences that are linked in topic. We shouldn't use a comma for this (these are called 'run on sentences!').

Careful not to try to link more than two sentences at a time.

Write 3-4 sentences that are made from two sentences connected by a semi-colon (;). (Can you include a semi-colon (or two!) anywhere in your writing today before you publish it?)



Write about anything you have done outside of school this week.
