# Synonyms

Synonyms are words or phrases that mean exactly or nearly the same as another word or phrase.

Sadness -> Sorrow -> Malcontent

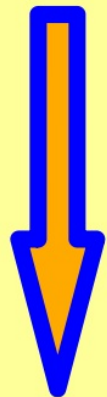

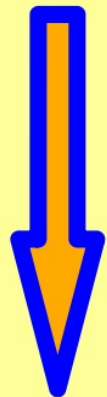
