What is persuasion?




When you are writing to persuade, you want to convince your reader about something. It might be that you're persuading them to buy your product or you could be persuading them that what you're saying is true.

There are different ways of writing to persuade.

- * Adverts/Posters
- * A persuasive talk/speech
- * A persuasive letter





Features of Writing to Persuade


The most important part of writing to persuade is being able to convince your reader. To do this effectively, you'll need to use a range of different features.

Alliteration


Alliteration is the use of a series of words beginning with the same consonant or syllabic sound. While alliteration doesn't usually give much added depth to writing, it can add humour and expression.
