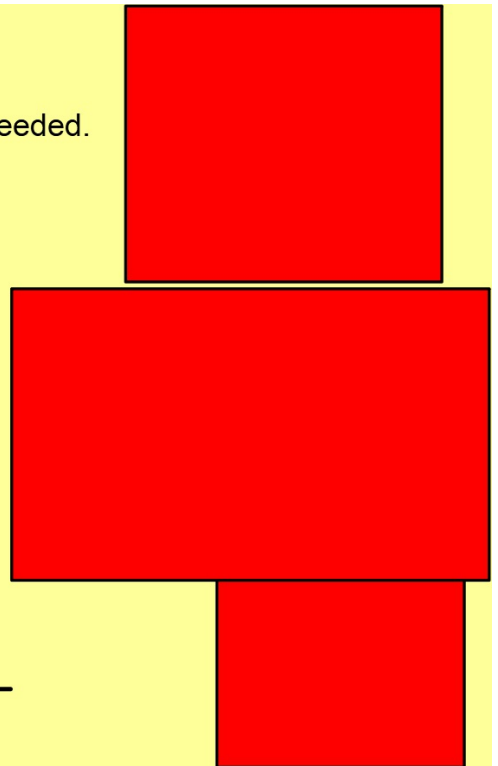

$8 \times 1 = 8$, but we need to add on the exchanged 2 from $8 \times 3 = 24$! So the digit in the H column should be 0. This then affects the digit in the TH column because we would need to add an exchanged 1!
