Writing	Hi All and we hope all's well! As we did before Lockdown we will be posting new resources weekly for any children isolating at home to work through. This is the final week of our balanced arguments writing and as well as finishing off our writing we would like you to then practise reading out your finished pieces and if you can to video them for us too! To start this week we will be editing our 'for' paragraph and the writing our 'against' paragraph. Make sure that you use your plans, if you have them, or the ideas for arguments sheets if you don't, so that you have several good points to write about. Next, it's a grammar input to practise making the most of parenthesis before you edit your 'against' paragraph and write your conclusion. The conclusion is the chance you get to finally include your own opinion! After this, it's time to practise reading out your speeches and to record/video them if you can before we finish with some reasoning for writing.
