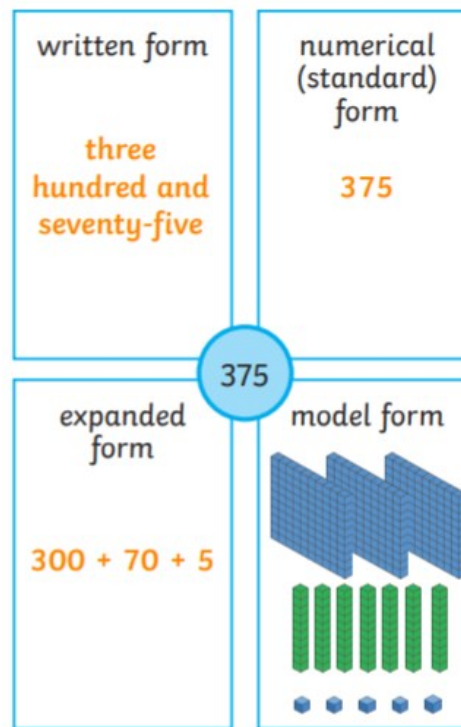
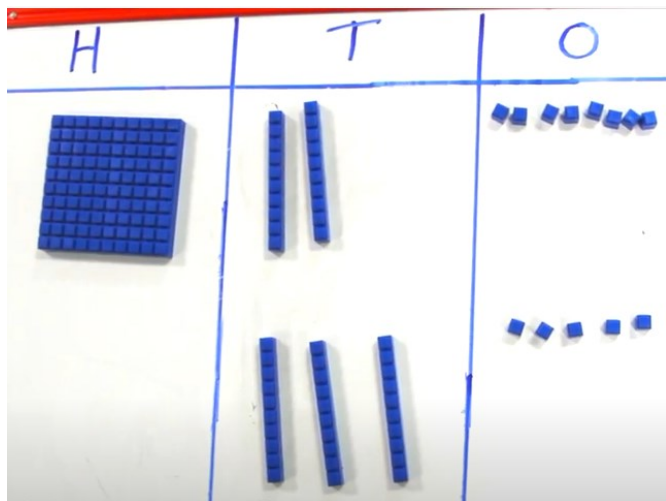




Where a digit is placed tells us how much it is worth. This is called **column value**.

If you have **more than 9** in any column, you can **make a group of 10** and move it into the **next biggest column**. We can **exchange** 10 ones into the **tens column** because we have **13** ones.
