


Maths

Chesswood Junior School – Weekly Learning



We'll start by looking at persuasive letter writing techniques and then work on how we can use paragraphs to organise our ideas and how we can use purpose, form and audience to better target our writing. In lesson 3 we will practise writing/ constructing cohesive paragraphs before finishing the week by editing what we've done and working on how uplevel our vocabulary, grammar and punctuation choices and then writing a conclusion. When you are done please take some pictures of your work and send them into you class teachers.



We will also be thinking about and talking about what kind of learning behaviours and learning skills we will need to develop to help us to become more independent learners. Please also work through the Turbo GPS and Nasty writing activities that we have also

uploaded and linked.

In response to government guidance over how to best cover the Maths curriculum following on from our recent lockdown experiences we are going to be revisiting parts of our Maths curriculum in order to ensure that the core Maths curriculum is fully understood and that as many of our Year 5 children as possible, are ready and fully prepared for Year 6 next year. This will mean some re-capping and will also mean that some children may feel that the work being offered is too easy for them. If this is the case for your child we would ask the following: 1) Please ask them to really think about their reasoning as this is an immensely important skill that they will need to develop further; 2) Use the extension resources uploaded and linked opposite; 3) If this is not enough please contact your class teacher and we will happily provide more work for you.

Please see the resources opposite and please also make sure that you look carefully at our key vocabulary lists as they will really help you and especially with your reasoning.
