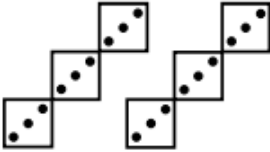


Write a multiplication number sentence for each example. One has been done for you.

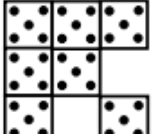


$3 \times 4 = 12$

I know... so...

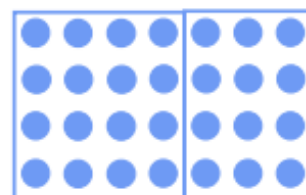
$7 \times 4 = \underline{\quad}$

$8 \times 4 = 32$

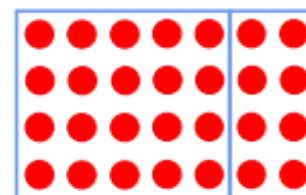


$8 \times 5 = \underline{\quad}$

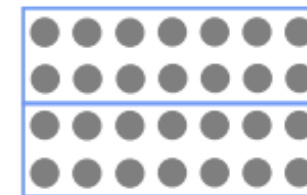
7×4 is the same as:

$\underline{5} \times \underline{4} + \underline{2} \times \underline{4}$

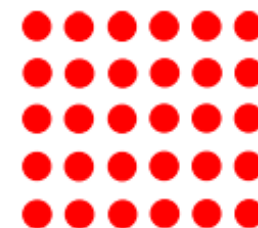


$\underline{7} \times \underline{2} + \underline{7} \times \underline{2}$
