	Stop, Drop and Roll	The three-step procedure in the event you encounter a fire. Stop where you are Drop to the ground Roll over and over until the fire is out	
	Family Plan	A decision your family makes of what to do if there is a fire in your home. You should practice like a school fire drill!	
	Smoke/Fire Detectors	A device that detects and warns if smoke is present. An alarm will sound to make all aware
