	Stranger	Someone who you do not know or who is unfamiliar to you	
	Trusted adult	A person over 18 who you feel safe with or that you can talk to easily	
	Safest route	Following a way home that you know very well. This will avoid places that are isolated and without dangerous roads to cross	
	Uncomfortable	To feel awkward or uneasy. Remember no one has the right to make you feel this way.	
	Safe place	Somewhere that you feel relaxed and at ease. This is a place where your trusted adult may be and you can be seen and safe.
