Features of Instruction Writing



This week we will be looking at how to write an instruction text.

What are instructions?

Features of Instruction Writing

- Imperative verbs are usually used within the method to 'boss' the reader around!
- Conjunctions, prepositions and adverbs to show time, place and cause should be used throughout, e.g. After that, Inside the box, As soon as it has melted, etc.
- Extra tips and advice may be given to the reader for especially tricky parts of a task.
- Pictures or diagrams can be used to provide clarification, e.g. a series of pictures or diagrams corresponding to each step of the method, a single picture or diagram of a tricky part of the process or an illustration of the final product.









Features of Instruction Writing

- Pictures or diagrams can be used to provide clarification, e.g. a series of pictures or diagrams corresponding to each step of the method, a single picture or diagram of a tricky part of the process or an illustration of the final product.
- A conclusion to sum up the task and help the reader check that they have achieved the correct outcome.



Layout devices will also be used to structure and organise the text. These may include headings and subheadings, underlining, bold or italic text, bullet points and numbers.

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How to make a pizza

In order to make and cook a perfect pizza, follow these quick and easy steps

Equipment Needed: Oven, flour, yeast, passata, cheese, oil and toppings

1. First, mix the flour, yeast and oil together to form a dough before adding 100ml of cold water.
2. Next, flour the work surface and carefully start to knead the dough using the heel, turn flip technique. Complete this for five minutes while the dough becomes more elastic.
3. Finally, roll out the dough using a rolling pin **and** then add a generous amount of tomato passata. Top your pizza with your favourite ingredients. Bake in a hot oven.



How to Care for a Mouskin

Over the last few years, mouskins have become the must-have pet. These long-whiskered, fluffy creatures look like a cross between a mouse and a cat and are gentle, highly intelligent animals. Are you thinking of getting a mouskin? Do you think you could care for one effectively? These instructions will tell you all you need to know to look after your new pet:

What you need:

- a carrier for travelling
- a large box or bed filled with straw for your pet to sleep in
- two bowls (one for food and one for fresh water)

Bringing your Mouskin Home

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Feeding your Mouskin

Mouskins need to be fed a 50/50 mix of nuts and tuna. Follow these steps to ensure your mouskin will be properly nourished and healthy:

1. To create seven portions of mouskin food, mix together 700g of nuts (any variety will do) and 700g of drained tuna. Blend the ingredients together to form a smooth paste.
2. Split the mixture into seven equal portions and spoon into containers with lids.
3. Store the containers in the fridge until you are ready to use them.
4. Serve your mouskin one portion per day, which needs to be split into two meals: breakfast and dinner.
5. At all times, ensure that your mouskin has a fresh supply of clean water.


Exercise and Play

As mouskins are intelligent and playful animals, you will need to provide him with a range of toys to keep him entertained and take him for regular walks. This will stop your mouskin from getting bored and help to distract him from chewing your furniture.

Follow these top tips to keep your mouskin fit, healthy and content:

1. Provide your mouskin with toys of different types and textures. He will like tough, rubbery toys to chew on and soft toys to cuddle up to.
2. Choose a designated playtime each day - after breakfast is an ideal time. Use this dedicated time to play games with your mouskin.
3. Set aside time in your day for two brisk thirty-minute walks. Always ensure your mouskin wears his collar and lead when outside the house.

Do you think you are ready to welcome one of these wonderful pets into your home? Owning a mouskin can be a pleasurable and rewarding experience for all the family. If you follow the above instructions, you and your mouskin will be assured a long and happy life together.

WALT edit and respond to feedback

Teacher notes:

With this lesson, you need to populate the next page with your chn's names after marking.

You can then use the first few slides (they are just templates to use or omit as you want) to share good writing and draw out where features of the SC have been used effectively. You can also draw out which aspects of grammar are incorrect or awkwardly used and then model improvements as a class.

Copy examples from the children's work to model this by typing up or adding a photo of the work to support.

(See Autumn 2 Week 10 NB Whole class mark to see how this worked.)

After this, choose common issues (eg in 3LB, lack of headings and subheadings and Subordinating conjunctions), and for each one (maybe 2-3), model how you would edit to include one, and then chn do it. I/we do, you do!

Chn then work to edit their work according to what the teacher has told them to do - optional slide at end with extra items to check if chn have finished.
