#### Here are some common purposes for using fronted adverbials:

#### **Fronted Adverbials**

Fronted Adverbials are words or phrases at the beginning of a sentence which are used to describe the action that follows.



When he was a child, Attenborough collected fossils and rocks.



...he still continues his conservation work.


...he attended Cambridge University.
