How many words can you think of that end in 'sion'?


Working with a partner, write down as many 'sion' words as you can think of in the next three minutes.





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Did you think of any of these 'sion' words?



All of the words that end in 'sion' have a root word that ends in either **de** or **se**. For example...







Let's spin the spinner!
