Spelling Week 2 commences Wednesday 07/07/21 and concludes Tuesday 13/07/21. Week 2 includes a midpoint assessment at the start of the week to identify which spellings the children have learnt during week I and a further spelling test at the end of the week to identify which spellings they learnt during the 2 weeks.
