This week, we are looking at words where the **shuhn** ending is made using 'ssion'.

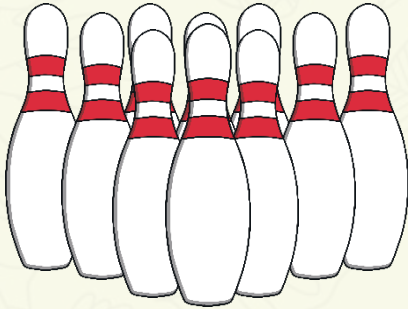
