Today we are going to design and create a board game. Next lesson, we are going to play them



Once you have thought of your topic and template for your game, you need to think about:

- How does the players win?
- Are there any consequences to the game?

You now need to write all the questions into your book. You also need to write answers as your game is going to come with answers.

Once you have finished, you need to get your partner to check your answers before you write them onto your game board.

You can now play each others board games.

After you have played a board game, you need to write some positive and one thing that the game could improve on a post-it.
