1. COVID-19 Update

We can confirm there have been no positive cases this week. We will be placing the below table in each newsletter to keep you updated on the number of either positive or potential cases. You can be assured that we are tracking everything carefully and responding to risks as they arise, balancing the need to stay open and the need to reduce risk and transmission. If you have any concerns in relation to any of these numbers, please contact <u>office@chesswood.w-sussex.sch.uk</u>. They are not a reason for a child to be absent from school. Should it be necessary for your child to isolate, we will be in contact.

Do NOT attempt to send your child to school for any reason if anyone in your household is displaying any one or combination of symptoms below:

- A new, continuous cough
- High temperature
- Loss, change in normal sense of taste or smell

If **anyone** has **any one** or more symptoms of coronavirus they must isolate with their household and seek a test or isolate for 10 days. Other members of the household must isolate for 14 days or until a negative test result has been received. 
3. Parents Evening – All – Please Read

There are now only 9 days left to complete your online secondary school application. Parents of children currently in Year 6 will need to complete the secondary school online admissions process, at the very latest by Saturday 31st October 11:59pm. We wish you every success in securing the school of your choice for your child. To ensure you have the very best chance of securing a school place in the local area – YOU MUST complete the online process BEFORE SATURDAY 31st OCTOBER 11:59 p.m. If you do not submit an application in time it is unlikely that your child will secure a school place within a Worthing school and extremely unlikely that your child will be placed at any of your preferred school. Please, please, please prioritise this process in the interests of your child's learning and happiness in the coming years.

5. Positive Case – All – Information

Earlier in the week, we were made aware of a member of our school community testing positive for COVID 19. We have contacted all families directly that we believe need to, and we are not able to reveal

(directly or indirectly) the identity of the case. Going forwards, we have developed a new online form to be completed by any member of the school community as soon as possible after developing symptoms. This includes weekends and holidays for the foreseeable future.

If any of the following are true:

- CHESSWOOD COVID RESPONSE This online questionnaire is for all members of the school community to complete whenever they have developed COVID symptoms and need to isolate or have received a positive test outcome. If is vital that every term is made to secure a ster as as ona a possible after symptoms are experienced as there are many vulnerables members in the school community that will need to take action once a test outcome is positive. The members completing this form and requiring time away from school must also complete the online staff absence form. * Required Contact Details 1. First Name of Person with symptoms *
- You child attending Chesswood has experienced symptoms
- Your child attending Chesswood has tested positive
- Anyone in your household experiences any one of the three symptoms
- You are a staff member, external staff (supply teacher, peripatetic music teacher) or volunteer and you or anyone in your household has developed symptoms or tested positive

You should complete the COVID 19 online form as soon as possible.

As indicated, it is our sincere hope that none of the above need to be used by any family or staff member. However, if it does, we expect that all members of our school community being aware of and using this online reporting system will allow a quick response in the interests of all members of our community, particularly those who are vulnerable themselves and those with vulnerable family members.

6. Year 2 Open Events 2020 – Wednesday 11th November – Information

A letter was circulated to all parents with children in Year 2 at Springfield and Lyndhurst Infant Schools. Unfortunately this year we are unable to hold our usual Open Day, however we will do our very best to create an open event that will inspire and engage parents and children alike. We know choosing a school for your child is one of the most important decisions parents make in life and we will ensure you have the right information available to make your decision in confidence. We will publish our open event materials ready for Wednesday 11th November. The materials will include virtual tours; and video presentations by children and staff. We will write again with the specific organisation for the open event but wanted to contact you early in the process to allay any worries you may have about the admissions

This form also enables families to ask or share up to three adult questions, queries or concerns. In addition, there is space to add up to three child led questions, queries or concerns. This form will close on **Monday 2nd November, 11:30pm**. We will then create a booklet for adult questions, queries and

concerns we have received and one for children (this will need to be read in partnership with their parents).

7. Amber Status – All – Information

We have now moved into the **amber** status of the risk assessment.

Stage	Description	Example Actions
3	There has been <u>one</u> positive case of a child or member of staff attending Chesswood Junior School within the past 14 days. The individual is required to isolate for at least 10 days and close contacts in school are required to isolate for 14 days and undertake a test.	A risk assessment review will be undertaken, control measures will be considered again whether they remain fit for purpose. Further advice will be sought from the local Public Health England team. Considerations for playground management, school assemblies, specialist teaching and cleaning rotas will be reviewed, amongst other things.

- Face coverings should be worn by visitors (age 12+) when:
 - On site
 - Queueing to enter the site
- Essential school entry only
 - Use email wherever possible or speak to staff on the gate
- Check your distance from others
- Avoid queueing
 - Arrive later (not late 😊)
- Reduce your risk and keep our school open for ALL

8. Home Learning During Isolation – All – Information

Should your child be in isolation, we are providing a phased approach to home-learning to minimise the

impact on their academic progress and to maintain links with the work being completed by children in school. When a child is in isolation at home, and is well enough to do so, they should go to:
