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## 1. COVID-19 Update

We can confirm there have been no positive cases this week. We will be placing the below table in each newsletter to keep you updated on the number of either positive or potential cases. You can be assured that we are tracking everything carefully and responding to risks as they arise, balancing the need to stay open and the need to reduce risk and transmission. If you have any concerns in relation to any of these numbers, please contact <u>office@chesswood.w-sussex.sch.uk</u>. They are not a reason for a child to be absent from school. Should it be necessary for your child to isolate, we will be in contact.

## Do NOT attempt to send your child to school for any reason if anyone in your household is displaying any one or combination of symptoms below:

- A new, continuous cough
- High temperature
- Loss, change in normal sense of taste or smell

If **anyone** has **any one** or more symptoms of coronavirus they must isolate with their household and seek a test or isolate for 10 days. Other members of the household must isolate for 14 days or until a negative test result has been received. ## 4. COVID Reporting – All – Information

We have developed a new online form to be completed by any member of the school community as soon as possible after developing symptoms. This includes weekends and holidays for the foreseeable future.

#### If any of the following are true:

- You child attending Chesswood has experienced symptoms
- Your child attending Chesswood has tested positive
- Anyone in your household experiences any one of the three symptoms



You are a staff member, external staff
 (supply teacher, peripatetic music teacher)
 or volunteer and you or anyone in your household has developed symptoms or tested positive

You should complete the COVID 19 online form as soon as possible.

As indicated, it is our sincere hope that none of the above need to be used by any family or staff member. However, if it does, we expect that all members of our school community being aware of and using this online reporting system will allow a quick response in the interests of all members of our community, particularly those who are vulnerable themselves and those with vulnerable family members.

For every correct answer to a multiplication or division question, your child will earn their class a point. The Times Tables Rock Stars platform will calculate the class average (the number of correct answers per pupil in the class who play during the competition hours). Winning classes in the school and in the country as a whole will be the ones with the highest average.

All game modes (Gig, Garage, Studio, etc.) will count but only from games played between 7:30am and 7:30pm on Monday 9<sup>th</sup>, Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup>, Thursday 12<sup>th</sup>, Friday 13<sup>th</sup> and Saturday 14<sup>th</sup>.



In the spirit of the competition, please don't play on their behalf but by all means encourage and support them to the extent that it doesn't cause high stress levels or impact on family plans. We suggest a limit of half an hour a day outside school hours – some will play more, some will play less.
