If you have any concerns in relation to any of these numbers, please contact office@chesswood.w-sussex.sch.uk. These figures are not a reason for a child to be absent from school. Should it be necessary for your child to isolate, we will be in contact.

- A new, continuous cough
- High temperature
- Loss, change in normal sense of taste or smell

If **anyone** has **any one** or more symptoms of coronavirus they must isolate with their household and seek a test or isolate for 10 days. Other members of the household must isolate for 14 days or until a negative test result has been received. 
3. Asthma Form – All – Action

Asthma forms must be updated annually, so this will be an annual requirement for parents who have a child with asthma.

The form below must be completed annually by parents for any child with a medical diagnosis for asthma. Additionally the form will need to be completed when the medication is ceased. 

A member of the Chesswood community tested positive for COVID-19. However, in line with national guidance and through consultation with the DFE there is no further action required for any child or staff member at school. 12. Chesswood Rocks! – TT Rock Stars Competition

Last week, the Chesswood community took part in a national competition run by TT Rock Stars. Rock Out 2020 was entered by:

- ★ 3,887 schools (including a mixture of primary, infant, junior, secondary and colleges)
- ★ 31,039 classes (some schools entered certain classes we entered every class)
- ★ 433,924 pupils


To take part, children simply needed to use TT Rock Stars. Each correct answer earned themselves a point. It's fair to say our Bright Sparks really did go the extra mile. I'm delighted to announce that we finished 115th in the country – which is in the top 3%! Our highest scoring class was 5AY – they finished 857th place, which is in the top 3% of classes. Over 80% of our classes finished in the top half of classes nationally.


A beautiful rainbow appeared over Chesswood...
