Then they moved to Fulham (in London). At 18 she started nursing and at 21 had my daddy. The nursing job didn't suit Granny G, as she was trying to raise a child whilst working working at night, so she later found a newspaper job. Then she changed jobs again to become a housing officer and finally, they moved to North Motts (when daddy was 14) so he could go to a particular school.
