- In School Assessment trialed in Year 3.

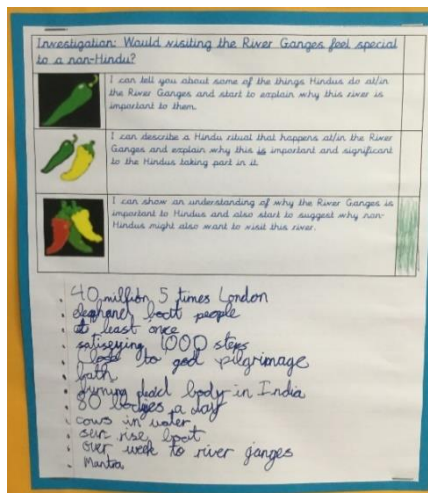
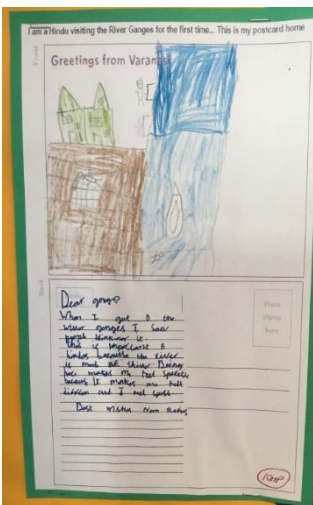
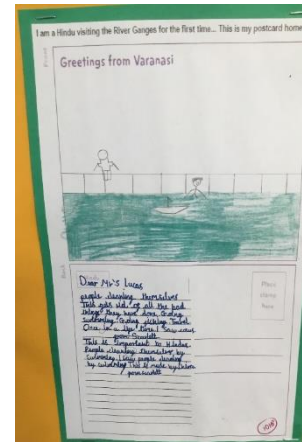
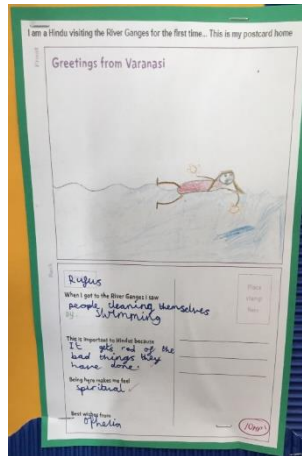
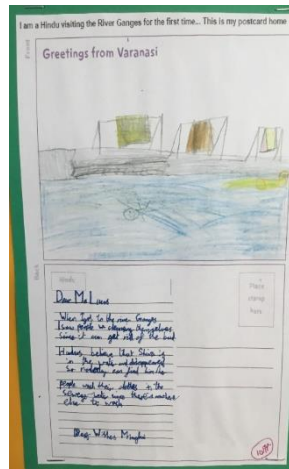

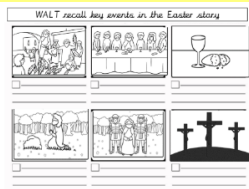
