I can explain how to order unit fractions using the numerator and denominator



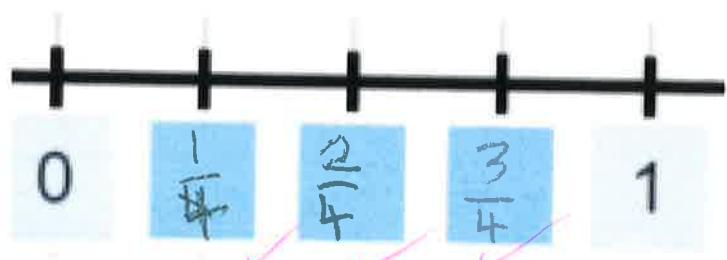
I can order unit fractions



With support, I can order unit fractions

Place the fractions on the number line.

$$\frac{2}{4} \quad \frac{3}{4} \quad \frac{1}{4}$$



Order the fractions from biggest to smallest.

$$\frac{3}{8} \quad \frac{5}{8} \quad \frac{1}{8} \quad \frac{8}{8} \quad \frac{7}{8}$$

$$\frac{8}{8} \quad \frac{7}{8} \quad \frac{5}{8} \quad \frac{3}{8} \quad \frac{1}{8}$$

When the numerators are the same, the bigger the denominator, the bigger the fraction.

Use 'bigger' or 'smaller' to complete the sentence.

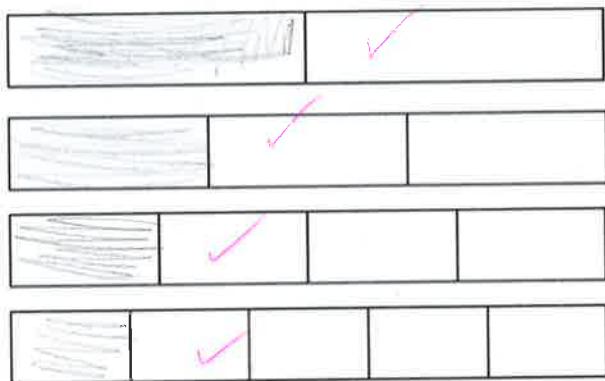
