Safe travel to and from school AND drop-off & collection



Parents are accountable for reducing risk and harm for their children, just as they are for all risks children face e.g. road safety, smoking, rail safety. It remains a sustained concern that there is a far more relaxed attitude to the very real dangers of online harm compared to other child-hood risks. We have created a clear guide on routine parent activities to help reduce risk and to identify risks or harm early so that children can enjoy the cyber world and have safe, fun and appropriate experiences.














COMPETITIONS!
