## <u>Household Support Fund – Help with the</u> rising cost of living

The government's 'Household Support Fund' is a scheme to support the most vulnerable people in our community, focusing on the rising cost of living.

"We are providing support to help the most vulnerable households deal with rising costs of essentials. If your application is successful, you will receive a voucher based on the size of your household, or support with paying essential household bills."

The scheme has been extended for a further 6 months and can be accessed through West Sussex County Council's Community Hub. You will need to provide evidence to support your application when completing the application form. The team will then assess your circumstances against their eligibility criteria.
