If your child requires an Asthma inhaler to be stored at school, you will need to complete an Asthma Information Form and a Parental Agreement form, which can be found by clicking on the link below. Please complete BOTH of the forms at the bottom of the web page.

Your child's inhaler must be in its original packaging (box) complete with pharmacist's label. It must be in date, clean and full.

If your child requires medication that has been prescribed by their GP and is to be taken more than 3 times a day or at specific times, then you will need to complete a Parental Agreement – prescribed medication form. Please click on the link below.

If your child requires non-prescribed medication, such as Calpol, the school can only administer the medication for up to 48 hours. After this time, your child will need to have it prescribed by a doctor. A Parental Agreement – non-prescribed form must be completed. Please click on the link below.

To ensure you have the very best chance of securing a school place in the local area – YOU MUST complete the online process **BEFORE SUNDAY 31st OCTOBER**. If you do not submit an application in time it is unlikely that your child will secure a school place within a Worthing school and extremely unlikely that your child will be placed at any of your preferred school. 12. Friends of Chesswood – All – Information


