4. Chesswood Road Parking - ALL - PLEASE READ

- At collection and drop off time, please ensure no part of a car you are driving or travelling in stops or parks on the white or yellow zig zag lines.
- Stopping or parking in the RED ZONES presents a VERY HIGH RISK TO CHILDREN AND IS ILLEGAL.
- Please avoid blocking residents' driveways as they may need access.





5. Absence Requests - ALL - Information

Please can all parents be aware that in order to request absence for your child during term time, you must complete the online Request for Absence Form. Under exceptional circumstances pupils may be granted absence from school. Any request for absence must be submitted BEFORE the absence is undertaken unless there is an emergency that would naturally take priority. Under normal circumstances, we would ask for a minimum of five working days' notice being given before the first day of absence. In an emergency, as a minimum, we would request a phone call on 01903 204141 or an email to office@chesswood.w-sussex.sch.uk to inform school of the absence and the reasons for it. We will still require the online form to be completed but understand other matters may need to take precedence, for example: an unexpected serious illness of a family member.

6. Contact Information - ALL - Action

If any of your contact details (e.g. phone number, email address, address) have changed recently, please remember to notify the school either by phone or email. We need to have up to date information so that we are able to contact you in an emergency, and to ensure you receive all relevant communication.

7. Medication – ALL – Action

If your child has an inhaler, epi-pen or any regular medication needed to be taken in school, please make sure these are in school, and you have filled out the relevant forms on our <u>website</u>.

8. 2022 Secondary School Admissions - Year 6 - Information

Parents of children currently in Year 6 will need to complete the secondary school online admissions process, at the very latest by Sunday 31st October 2021. We have created a page on our website to guide parents through the application process, and that can be visited here.

To ensure you have a reference for all available information we have created two web pages to support parents of Year 6 children

- 1. <u>General Secondary Admissions</u> importantly this includes website links to all secondary schools in the area. It also indicates which schools have special educational needs specialist support centres for children that currently have or are likely to be registered with an Education and Health Care Plan.
- 2. <u>Specific 2021 Secondary Admissions Arrangements</u> this includes the attached letters for your reference and information including a link to the West Sussex website and their leaflets and posters with the key information for all parents.

We wish you every success in securing the school of your choice for your child. To ensure you have the very best chance of securing a school place in the local area – YOU MUST complete the online process **BEFORE SUNDAY 31st OCTOBER**. If you do not submit an application in time it is unlikely that your child will secure a school place within a Worthing school and extremely unlikely that your child will be placed at any of your preferred school. Please, please, please prioritise this process in the interests of your child's learning and happiness in the coming years. The admissions website can be found here.

9. Homework – ALL – PLEASE READ

Following feedback, research and consultation, we have introduced a new system of homework to be more targeted to each child's needs, easier for children and parents to access and simpler for teachers to track. The children will be taught how to access their homework in the first two weeks of term and guidance will be provided to help adults access their child's homework. As with all new ventures, there will be some teething problems, so please bear with us and do report any issues to your class teacher so that they can be corrected for the future. The first day that homework will be issued is Friday 17th September.

Girls' Net

Girls' Net is a six-week journey for girls equipping them for times of challenge and change.

The course is made up of six 11/4 hour sessions in a small group of same-age girls guided by a fully trained Girls' Net Mentor.

In between the sessions, girls have an interactive notebook online to prompt further exploration of each week's topic.

Girls' Net is currently held online for girls grouped by age (8-18 years).

By the end of the course, the girls not only have some practical tools for managing their emotions, but they will have also had the experience of shared support.

Online Parenting Through Difficult Times

This three-week course is designed to help parents and carers of children of all ages achieve a sense of calm and safety and to give their children and young people tools for managing their big feelings (includes private online group and individual support).

Please note that groups are limited to 10 parents per course.

The funding for these courses runs from September 2021 to March 2022 and we are keen to have as many participants as possible to fill the courses (24 groups for Girls' Net and 12 Parenting Courses).
