TT Rock Stars fever hit Chesswood this week as part of the national England Rocks competition, to help celebrate Maths Week. Over 400 children from all year groups participated and achieved some very impressive results!

We are delighted to confirm that Chesswood finished with the 2nd highest total score of all competing nearby primary schools. When all competing schools are factored in, Chesswood still secured a very impressive 15th out of 3,869 schools – comfortably in the top 1%!

Chesswood entered 2 teams into the Y5/6 Gymnastic competition at Davisons on Thursday afternoon. All 16 gymnasts had to complete a vault and floor routine which were both scored out of 10 with the top 6 from each team having their scores combined for the overall team total.



Ben C from Y6 managed to score the highest total of all gymnasts amassing 19.2 out of 20 for his 2 elements – he scored a perfect 10 on the vault. Maiya J-B score 9.8 on her vault and Edith was top girl from Chesswood on the floor routine with 8.75.
