| Although he enjoyed drawing from a young age, he did<br>not devote himself completely to art until he was 27.<br>When he first started drawings he sketched using pen-<br>cils, water colours or charcoal sticks, before eventual-<br>ly beginning to paint using oil paints. In his early career<br>he used a lot of dark colours and liked to draw pictures<br>of poor hardworking people but in<br>1886 he moved to France where he<br>began to use brighter more vibrant<br>colours, representative of the sun-<br>ny weather conditions. Although he<br>wasn't famous during his lifetime<br>he is now considered one of the<br>greatest and most influential artists<br>of his time | Sunflowers (1888)<br>This painting was considered a master of still life<br>paintings and ranks amongst the most famous still<br>life paintings ever created.
