What is collage?

Collage is a work of art made by gluing pieces of different materials to a flat surface. In Marc Martin's book 'A River' each page is filled with fantastic images of places the river flows through, many of which are illustrated using collage.

Making a foam stamp



1) Design a pattern to use on your collage
