Step 5-Place your light source in the top right corner of your page, and add few more rows of spikes to the left side of the shape.




Step 6—Draw scribbles around the third circle. Keep scribbling more circling lines around and around the shape to create a messy-looking ball of dryer lin Continue to explore this idea of texture as a tool for shading.

or use the skills you have learnt to create textured animals like this Koala.
