

Collection arrangements

We are asking ALL parents if they have a change of collection arrangements to please email the school office on office@Chesswood.w-sussex.sch.uk by 2.30pm. This box is frequently checked during the day.

We understand that on occasions arrangements need to be changed for end of day collection. However, recently we have been receiving calls late in the school day which means that sometimes we can't get the messages to class teachers as the class have already been dismissed.

Trading and Games Cards

All children are allowed to bring trading cards e.g. match attack or games cards e.g. Pokemon; as long as they follow these rules

- A maximum of 25 in total of any combination of cards at any time in school.
- The child is responsible for them and for looking after them
- They are traded fairly at normal playground rates – a fair trade cannot be undone without freewill of both children.
- Include other children in games on request and when appropriate

School books amnesty

We will be holding a reading book amnesty in school over the next 2 weeks ahead of the end of term. If you have any Chesswood reading books at home or at the bottom of a school bag that your child is no longer reading, please can these be returned to your child's class teacher as soon as possible. These can usually be identified by having a white label on the spine of the book which contains a reading level and points. They may also have a white label stating, 'Reading for All Mr Gilbert'.

Why is this important?

As you will be aware, we use Accelerated Reader to help support and monitor reading within school – this is particularly useful in identifying books which are the right level of challenge for each child, through their zpd.

For children in Years 3 and 4, these are typically between 0.5 and 4.0. As a result of the Covid-pandemic, we are finding a significant number of children in both year groups need to access books levelled between 0.5 and 2.5. We have made sizeable investment in books of these levels; however, we are finding that these books are not routinely being returned to trays in school once they have been issued to or selected by children, meaning they aren't available to support children as hoped.

Whilst we will continue to work on systems within school and support children in learning to and remembering to return these, we are asking if you could please carefully check at home in case any additional books can be returned.

Report an illegally parked vehicle
